The visit to Balcarres House is by the kind consent of Lord and Lady Balniel. The estate has been in the hands of the Lindsay family since 1585. The first house was built in 1595, and has been re-modelled over the years, including 19th century additions by William Burn and David Bryce. It stands in beautiful landscaped gardens and parkland, developed over many years by Lady Crawford. The park includes a chapel, Gothic folly and doocot. After the visit to the house and gardens, refreshments will be served.
