

EAST NEUK OF FIFE PRESERVATION SOCIETY

*Guided tour of St Athernase Church, Leuchars, KY16 0EL
On Saturday 26th May at 3pm*

This is the best preserved Romanesque parish church in Scotland according to Professor John R Hume, though the nave was replaced in the nineteenth century. It displays remarkable exterior decoration in the form of blind arcading while inside chevron decorated arches draw the eye to the apse and beyond. Many mason's marks can be seen, of which several are identical to some in Durham cathedral. Distinctive corbels of human and animal form are found inside the apse and in a course outside the chancel.

Leuchars is north of St Andrews by the A91. At the Guardbridge roundabout turn right onto the A919 through Guardbridge. Go past the turn off for the Leuchars military base on the right and the train station on the left into Leuchars itself. At the roundabout turn right onto Main Street and follow the signs to the Church. Refreshments will be served after the tour.
