*Visit to the gardens of Wormistoun House, by Crail KY10 3XH
On Saturday 30th June at 3pm

The gardens and grounds have been painstakingly restored over the last 20 years. The walled garden is a series of 'rooms' including a wildlife meadow, productive potager, magical Griselinia garden, wildlife ponds and rill and recently planted mid and late season perennial borders. We will be given an introductory talk by Head Gardener Katherine Taylor. The visit will conclude with drinks and canapés.

Wormistoun is 1 ½ miles north of Crail by the A917 Crail/ St Andrews road. Past B9171 to Colinsburgh on left and cottage on right and immediately after cottage, turn right into lane with a grass triangle island in the middle of it. After passing stone cottage entrance is 100m. *From St Andrews* past Kingsbarns Distillery and in approx ½ mile and just before the road bends sharply to the right, turn into a minor lane on your left and as above.
